Dusk is a tribute to the immersive landscape of Tamatea/Dusky Sound in Fiordland, South Island, Aotearoa.

Dusk is our first portable, LED battery-powered light, designed to move with you. It adapts to any interior space, from intimate corners to open living areas and offers warm, ambient light whether resting on a bedside table or carried outdoors.

Dusk is available in one standard size with two material finishes: Sylvicta and Birch Plywood. The Sylvicta option also offers four printed designs: Christmas Orchid, Creeping Clubmoss, Shield Fern, and Hound's Tongue.

Mist: Sylvicta - Biogradable Recyclable Paper - 320gsm

Birch: KoskiFlex - Birch plywood - 0.7mm



KoskiFlex is a thin plywood manufactured from high-quality Finnish birch veneer. Strong yet highly flexible, Its light natural color and fine grain pattern provide a clean surface finish. KoskiFlex is PEFC® and FSC® certified, ensuring sustainable and responsibly sourced material.

Designs

Each light features an image of specimens that David collected and photographed during his time in Dusky Sound in Fiordland for the Tamatea ART project.

Hounds Tongue



A common fern from coastal to mountain areas, growing either on the ground, over rocks or on tree trunks and branches.

Shield Fern



A hardy native fern found from coastal regions to the mountains. With dark green, coarsely toothed fronds, it thrives on forest floors and banks. Its name comes from the shield-like coverings beneath its fronds that protect the spore clusters, giving it both its form and character.

Christmas Orchid




A graceful native orchid that grows epiphytically on trees in the forests of New Zealand. It features slender, bamboo-like stems with narrow leaves, and bursts into clusters of delicate white flowers in summer. Named the Christmas Orchid for its bloom in December and January.


Creeping Clubmoss



A distinctive groundcover plant, often found along mossy banks and shrublands throughout New Zealand. Its creeping stems stretch across the forest floor, producing yellow-green leaves and upright, cone-like spore structures. Despite its name, it is not a moss but a fern ally, celebrated for its soft, carpet-like growth.
